

# Bernards Township Democratic Committee Civic Scholarship Program

The Bernards Township Democratic Committee (BTDC) civic scholarship, founded in 2019, is awarded to a Ridge High School student entering their first year of college or senior year of high school who aspires to foster democratic values. The chosen applicant will receive \$1,500.00. In the past, recipients have also received the opportunity to intern with New Jersey Congressman Tom Malinowski (D-NJ 7<sup>th</sup> District) at his New Jersey district office in Somerville. Due to covid restrictions, at this time we are not able to offer the internship opportunity. If the current situation continues to improve, an opportunity to intern for Congressman Malinowski may become available this summer.

Should the internship occur, the selected student would be expected to fulfill the responsibilities of the role, and if the work is in-person, to provide their own mode of transportation to the office, at 76 Bridge Street.

Applications may be submitted to the BTDC scholarship committee from February 1 – April 16 of the year you are requesting consideration. All information submitted will be held in confidence, and used solely for the purpose of scholarship administration.

#### Instructions:

- 3. Provide the recommendation instructions to your Sponsor (e.g. High School instructor, Staff, Community Representatives) as described on page five. Recommendations must be printed or typed and included with submission of the full application.
- 4. Attach a copy of a transcript of your courses. This transcript must include your high school attendance record. If your transcript does not include your attendance record, please ask your school to provide an official report.
- 5. Complete all information so that it is legible. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
- 6. Final candidates will be invited to have an interview with the scholarship committee. You will be contacted via email to set up an interview so please check the email you have provided in this application regularly.
- 7. It is suggested that you have your application reviewed by your guidance counselor, the individual writing your recommendation, or another sponsor to insure completeness and accuracy.

Completed applications must be **submitted by April 16, 2021** to the address below. Applications postmarked on April 30 will be accepted.
